Notice of 2011 CDSOA Chesapeake Fleet Fall Cruise

Friday September 23rd -- Thursday September 29th

This year our fall cruise will offer many new opportunities for those adventurous sailors who may have never before explored the Southern Bay.

1) I am excited about the opportunity for us to enjoy a solo concert by Robbin Thompson. A noted sailor, song writer, and musician, best known by sailors for his songs: "Sweet Virginia Breeze," "Chesapeake Moon," and "Out on the Chesapeake." Jack & I first met him while sailing on the Pawtuxet years ago.

He will be performing solo from 6-8 pm September 24th at the Deltaville Maritime Museum, admission \$10 payable at the gate, proceeds to benefit the museum. I have been in contact with Robbin and he noted that the concert is "cooler friendly." A friend who is a docent at the museum will arrange for us to bring dinghies in to the museum dock. She is also willing to conduct a private tour of the museum prior to the concert if there is enough interest. I have detailed information about many of the historic houses and other sites which was compiled in 2000. Copies will be made available to cruise participants. It even includes some ghost stories.
- 3) We plan to have the cruise dinner in Reedville on Thursday Sep 29th at the Crazy Crab. The proprietor assures me they will be open and can supply individual checks. They have a small marina and a dinghy dock. There is an excellent anchorage near by.

Reedville has an interesting main street with a number of sea captains houses and a walking tour map. The Reedville Fisherman's Museum is also within walking distance.
